- Include an early career researcher\* (Principal Investigator or Co-Investigator)

\*Early career researcher is defined as within 10 years post PhD graduation (taking into consideration career disruption and relative to opportunity)

Applications will be reviewed by an external panel and successful applicants will be informed by email September 2019.
