



WORKS NOTIFICATION

GRATTAN STREET WEST SERVICE RELOCATIONS FROM 14 FEBRUARY 2020

To construct two station entrances outside the Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre and The Royal Melbourne Hospital, underground service relocations and associated works need to be completed.

The next stage of underground service relocations involves short-term traffic changes including the closure of Grattan Street, between Flemington Road and Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade, for up to five weeks. During this time, there will also be weekend closures of the northbound service lane on Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade.

Following service relocations, Grattan Street eastbound lanes will reopen to traffic and station entrance construction will commence on Grattan Street, adjacent to the Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre.

To enable station entrance construction and associated works to take place, Grattan Street westbound lanes, between Flemington Road and Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade, will remain closed for three years.

Further information about these works, including dates and timing, will be provided.

What we are doing

Service relocations

- Establishing work sites and implementing traffic changes on Grattan Street, between Flemington Road and Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade, including line-marking to indicate changed traffic conditions
- In preparation for changed traffic conditions, there will be changes to parking on Grattan Street from 8pm, Tuesday 11 February

- Service relocation works will involve saw-cutting and non-destructive digging (NDD) to expose the service underneath, excavating, laying new conduits and pipes, backfilling and reinstating roads and footpaths
- These works are expected to generate medium to high levels of noise.

Tree removal

- Removing one tree on Elizabeth Street
- Setting up a temporary work zone on Elizabeth Street and using a chainsaw and stump grinder
- Intermittent high levels of noise are expected
- Every effort has been made to minimise tree removal and only trees affected by current works and approved through Heritage Victoria are subject to removal.

When

Service relocations

- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 24 hours, from 6pm Friday to 7am Monday
- Please note, if additional out of hours work is required, directly adjacent stakeholders will be notified.

Station entrance construction and associated works

- Following service relocations, for three years
- Further information will be provided.

What to be aware of

- Temporary fencing, signage and traffic management will be in place around the work site
- Access to hospitals, including for emergency services, and businesses will be maintained at all times
- All works being undertaken will be in line with the Environmental Performance Requirements (EPRs).

TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORT CHANGES

Long-term traffic and transport changes

Station entrance construction and associated works

- Grattan Street westbound lanes will be closed between Flemington Road and Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade for three years
- The right-hand turn from Royal Parade southbound lane into Grattan Street will be permanently closed to traffic.

Short-term traffic and transport changes

Service relocations

- Grattan Street will be closed between Flemington Road and Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade
- Access for buses, cyclists, and emergency vehicles travelling eastbound on Grattan Street to Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade will be maintained under traffic management
- On weekends, the Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade northbound service lane will be closed from Grattan Street to just north of The Royal Melbourne Hospital and there will be additional lane closures in place on Elizabeth Street, Peel Street and Haymarket Roundabout.

Access to The Royal Melbourne Hospital and Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre on Grattan Street

- Vehicles accessing Grattan Street from Flemington Road for the taxi zone, drop-off/pick-up parking and disability parking will be required to perform a U-turn and exit via Flemington Road
- Taxi zones will be relocated further west on Grattan Street.

Emergency vehicle access

- Access will be maintained for emergency services at all times.

Cyclist changes

- Cyclists travelling eastbound on Grattan Street to Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade will be able to under traffic management
- Cyclists wanting to travel westbound on Grattan Street to Flemington Road can walk their bikes from Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade
- On weekends, cyclists travelling northbound on Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade will be diverted into the northbound centre lane from Haymarket Roundabout.

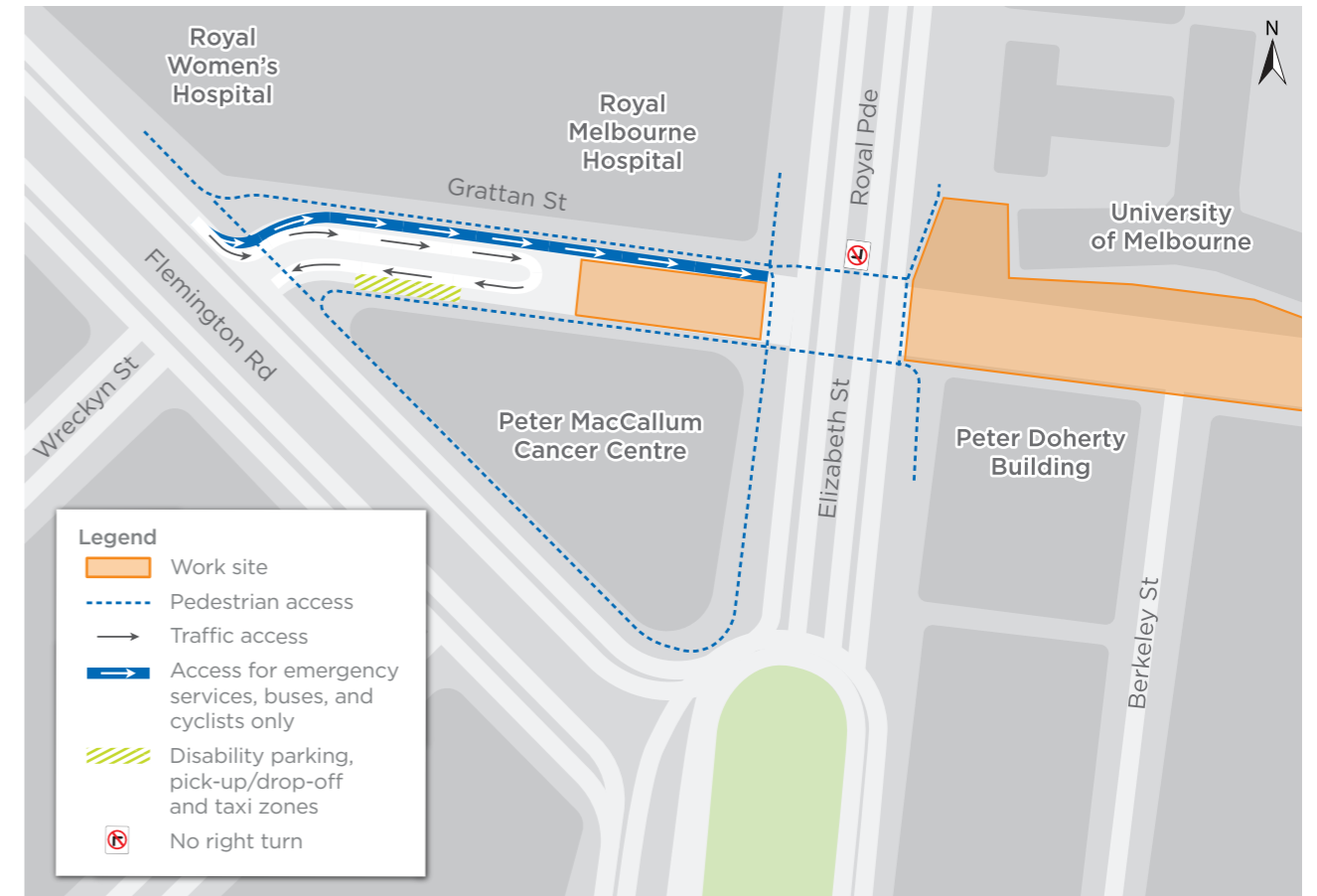
Pedestrian changes

- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times, with some diversions in place around the work site
- Signage and wayfinding will be installed around the work site to safely direct pedestrians.

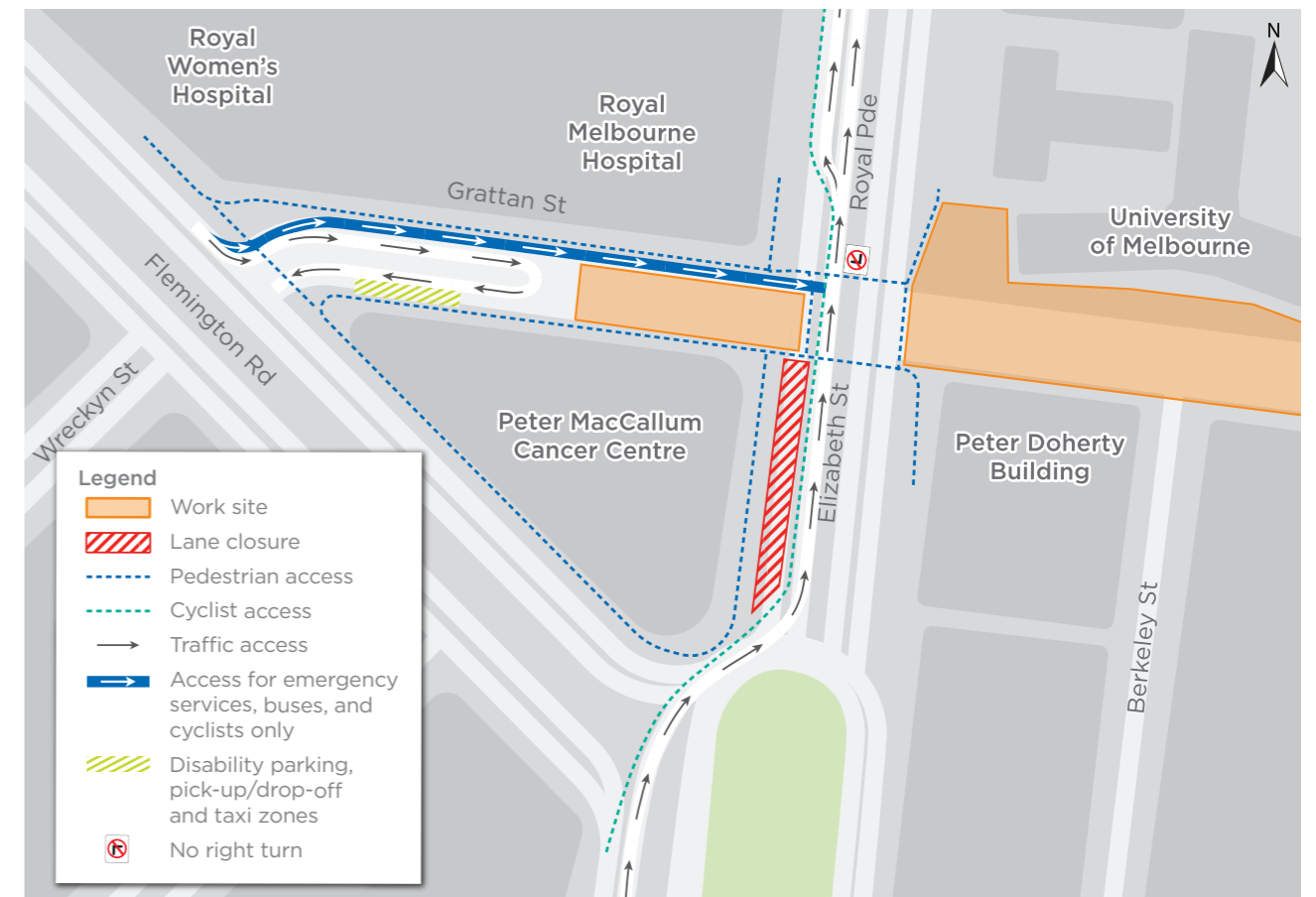
Public transport

- There will be no changes to trams services during the works
- On weekends, the bus route 505 will not service The Royal Melbourne Hospital/Royal Parade stop. Passengers are advised to use the alternative bus stop at Morrah Street/Royal Parade, located 250 metres north on Royal Parade
- There will be no changes to the 401, 402, 403, 501 and 546 bus services.
